The drinking-fountain was built by Al-Amir-'Abd ar-Rahmān Katkhoda (1), who founded numerous establishments besides this. It is considered his finest and most important monument owing to the variety of skill that about it indicates. Moreover, it is situated in a spot crowded with monuments of various Islamic Periods.

The drinking-fountain is built of great artistic importance. It has three facades interspersed with coloured marble areas, but their composition is made of fine marble. On the opening, pretty heavy windows have been installed, and above it, there is a small school (Kutāb) which consists in partitions of turned wood. The main door is very attractive. It is lined with coloured marble and decorated with inscriptions commemorating the founder's name and the date of the foundation. The floor is made of fine marble.

The room inside is covered with rare mosaic patterns, and on one part of its eastern wall there is a painting which represents the Holy Ka'ba.
