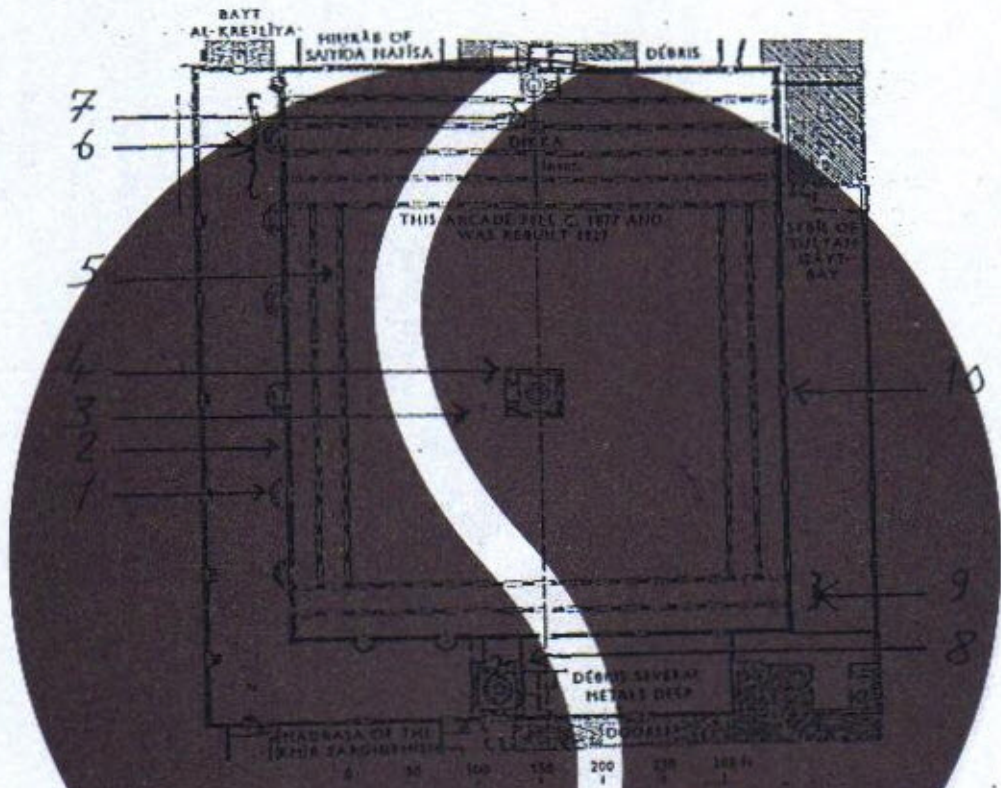

2) Translate the following into Arabic:

A) Luster Metallic Jar With a Hound Attacking a Hare (11th century)

This jar is a lusterware painted ceramic that has an oval body shape. It has a narrow bottom and ends without a base. The upper part ends with an opening. The shaft is divided into three sections. Each section is decorated with a scene of a hound attacking a hare. A broad border separates each scene with floral design in the shape of split palmettos. The hound attacks the hare by clenching his forepaw and hindpaw into the hare's back. The hound grabs the hare's neck between his jaws to control it.
