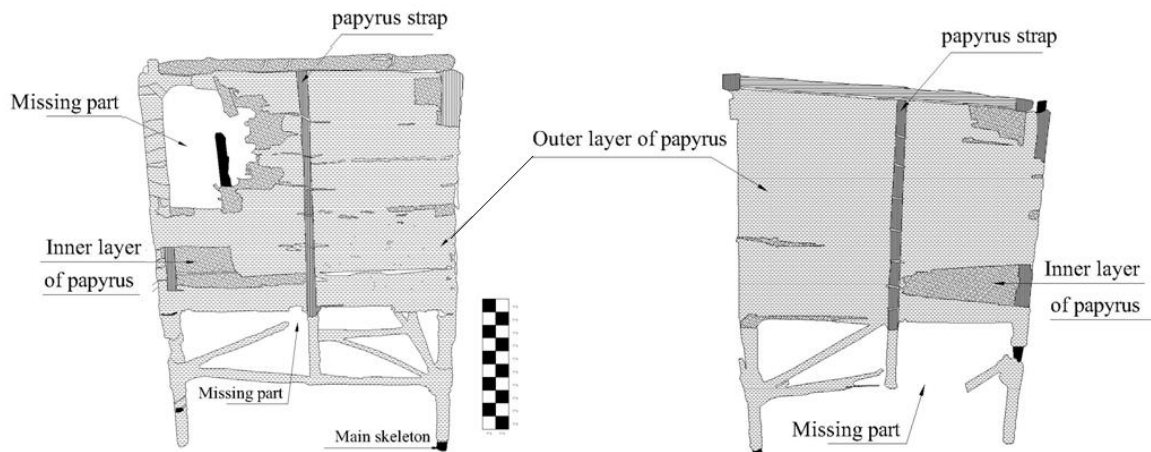
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2) The following wig box has several missing parts. What are the options that could be proposed to preserve the box with its contents?
